As most of you know, we are in a three year period of significant change, to revitalise our church and make it strong, healthy and viable for generations to come.



We understand mission to involve telling and teaching others about Jesus as well as tending to their needs through service, transforming unjust structures and treasuring the creation around us. Numbers don't tell the real story, but here's a summary of the people we've engaged with in 2024:

The Church is predominantly a self-funded organisation. Your regular financial giving is the baseline against which all our ministry is planned and conducted.

Our Vicars and Curate salaries are paid for by the Diocese. We pay the Diocese an annual fee (parish share) as a contribution to Diocesan costs, and we pay for 50% curate housing costs.

We receive grant funding from several sources, including the LNG Project which stops in Summer 2025.



We are bringing new life and energy to our Sunday services and encouraging everyone in church to participate regularly in Alpha and to join a midweek Connect Group. As well as that, we know that churches only have a future if we are engaging well with the next generation. Our key verse this year is from Matthew and shows Jesus making a priority and an example of young people.

# To-Do in 2025:

- Strengthen financial giving
- Launch parent and toddler group and Sunday Creche
- Start Sunday youth provision
- Start two new Connect groups
- Continue running three Alpha courses
- Update notice board and improve lighting inside and outside church for increased visibility
- Relaunch Lilyfield into a missional community
- Continue to reach out to our local community



We're committed to increasing our parish share by £5,000 to total £25,000 this year (and £30,000 next year). That's the financially viable place we need to be to secure ongoing clergy provision for the Church. It's a big challenge, but we want to increase our Annual Giving by at least £19,000 this year. To achieve this we'll be thinking about how we steward our money and helping every person understand where our money comes from and how it is spent in Church.
